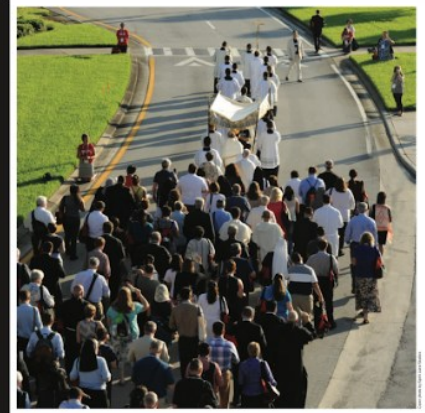

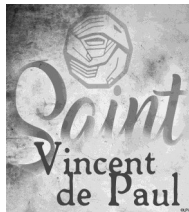
40 Hours Devotion Save the Date June 27-28

PLANNING MEETING WITH MISSOURI RIGHT TO LIFE

Thursday, July 24th at 7:00pm

This is an initial meeting to support a replacement amendment for banning abortion. Leaders are needed in planning and volunteering to get the new amendment passed. It will correct the harm of the health and safety standards that were removed with Amendment 3. There is a lot of planning that needs to happen. With this amendment, it would be great to see a greater involvement at the front end so we can have a consolidated focus.

Dear Respect Life Parish Coordinators and Friends of the Respect Life Apostolate,

We wanted to share with you the latest update on the status of abortion in Missouri. It concerns the recent good news that the Missouri Supreme Court overruled the lower court's decision which prevented our state's pro-life laws from being enforced after Amendment 3 passed.

As a result, as of right now, Missouri's strong pro-life laws are back in effect with abortions banned again throughout our state including St. Louis (except as allowed under the previous law). While we're unsure of how long this may last, we are grateful for any delay which saves preborn lives and protects women.

Missouri Catholic Conference director Jamie Morris sent the following quote to OSV:

We are happy that Missouri's pro-life laws will, for the time

being, remain in effect. These laws include common sense health and safety regulations, including basic cleanliness standards for abortion clinics. While we know that another injunction may ultimately be issued, we are thankful that Missouri women will be protected from an unregulated abortion industry in the immediate term.
